- b) Travel nationally or abroad related to artistic or scientific development, academic pursuits, leadership development, or entrepreneurship training.
- c) Project materials related to artistic or scientific development, academic pursuits, leadership development, or entrepreneurship training.
- d) Experiences or projects outside these categories at the discretion of the trustees of the Chagrin Falls Educational Foundation.
